- 3) Level 3 only, fill out Ontario Lacrosse Registration form for Provincials. Even if you are not planning to do Minor provincials this year, still fill the form out and return it with no circle.

If all the forms are not completed this could jeopardize your spot at the clinic you wish to attend

Note: Any returning referee must send in their forms into the office by Tuesday March 20th for all clinics. If the association is paying for your clinic, contact your local RIC to inform him/her that you would like to referee in 2007. This way they can keep track of how many referees are coming from their area.

The dates and locations of these clinics have been finalized. All clinics are being held in an educational setting. These will be the only Level 1/2 and 3 clinics. To referee in 2007 you must attend one of them.

The minimum age for a Referee is 14 years. Any Referee turning 14 (2nd year Bantam) during the year is eligible to attend.

NOTE: ANY OFFICIAL WHO HAS NEVER REFEREED LACROSSE BEFORE MUST ATTEND THE LEVEL 1/2 CLINIC.
IF YOU ARE A RETURNING LEVEL 2 REFEREE AND YOU ARE TURNING 18 IN 2006, YOU MAY ATTEND THE LEVEL 3 CLINIC AT THE COST OF \$120.00. ANY LEVEL 3 WHO DID NOT OFFICIATE IN 2006 WILL BE CHARGED AN ADDITIONAL \$15 TO COVER THE COST OF THE EQUIPMENT GAUGE.
THE COST FOR A RETURNING LEVEL 3 IS \$105.00

Returning Level 3	\$105.00

The cost of a Level 1/2 clinic is Eighty Five (\$85.00) dollars. In addition anyone who has not refereed before will be charged an additional Forty (\$40.00) dollars to cover the cost of:

- 1) Referee Jersey
- 2) Referee Manual
- 3) Rule Book

PURCHASE OF THESE ITEMS IS NOT OPTIONAL

Registration at all clinics will be 8:30 am to 9:15 am. Clinics will run from 9:15 am to 4:30 pm approximately. There will be a short lunch break.

Returning Referees attending these clinics should have a good knowledge of the rules before attending.

NOTE: The method of payment that we will accept is the following: money order, certified cheque, personal cheque, cash or a cheque from the association. Any cheque returned N.S.F. will have an additional charge of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars added.

"Please send your Clinic information back to the OLA in a timely fashion. We will be accepting applicants on a first come, first serve bases. If site is full, you will have to attend one of the remaining clinics. "

All returning level 1-2 referees must be pre-registered and their clinic fee sent to the OLA prior to the clinic. All level 3 referees must pre-register and forward their clinic fee to the OLA as noted on the registration form. All entry level referees must register and pay at the clinic.

- **In order to get an accurate count on the number of officials attending each clinic, we are starting to have everyone pre-registered before attending.**
- **Make sure all forms are filled in and returned with the cheque by March 20, 2006**

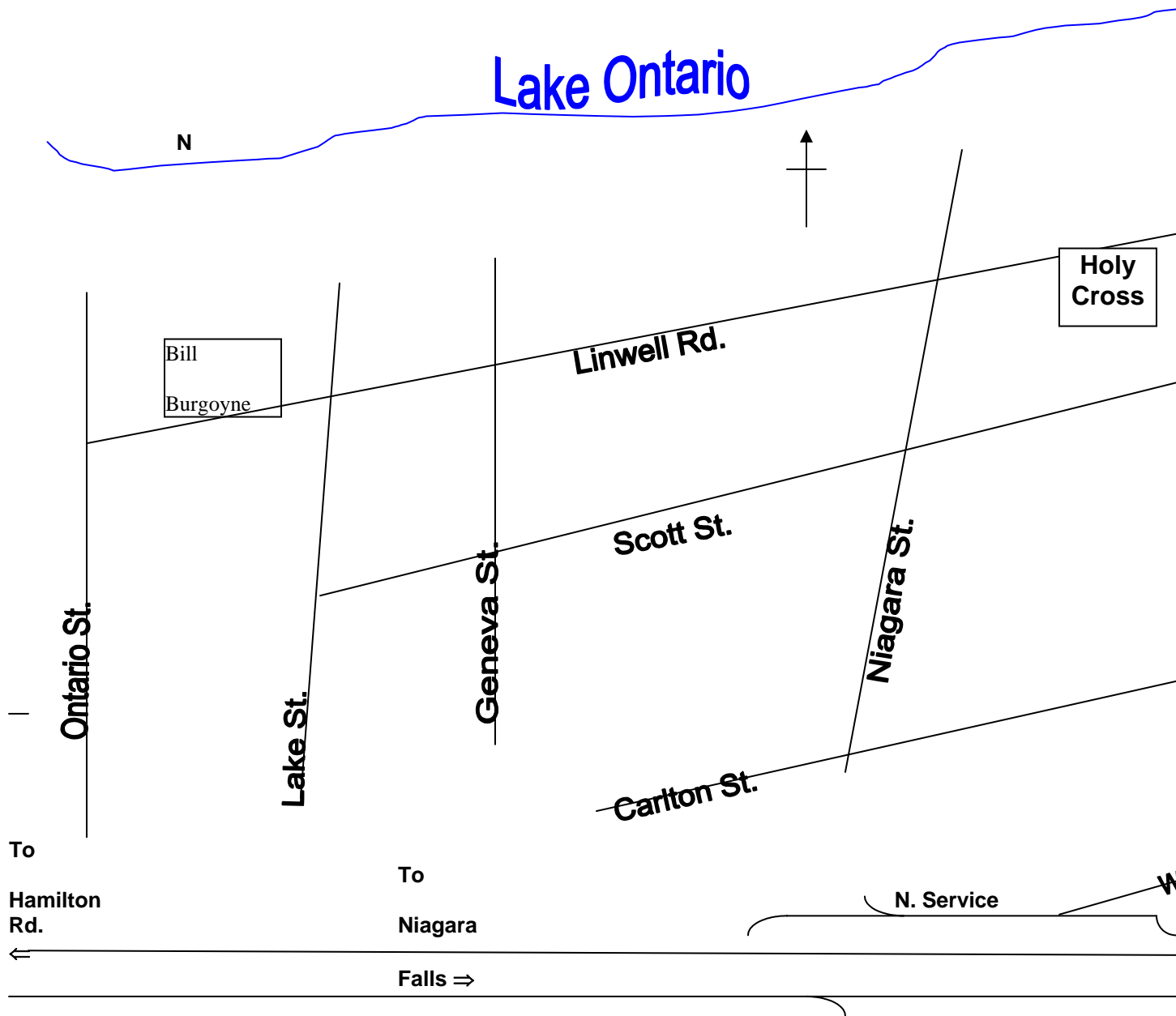

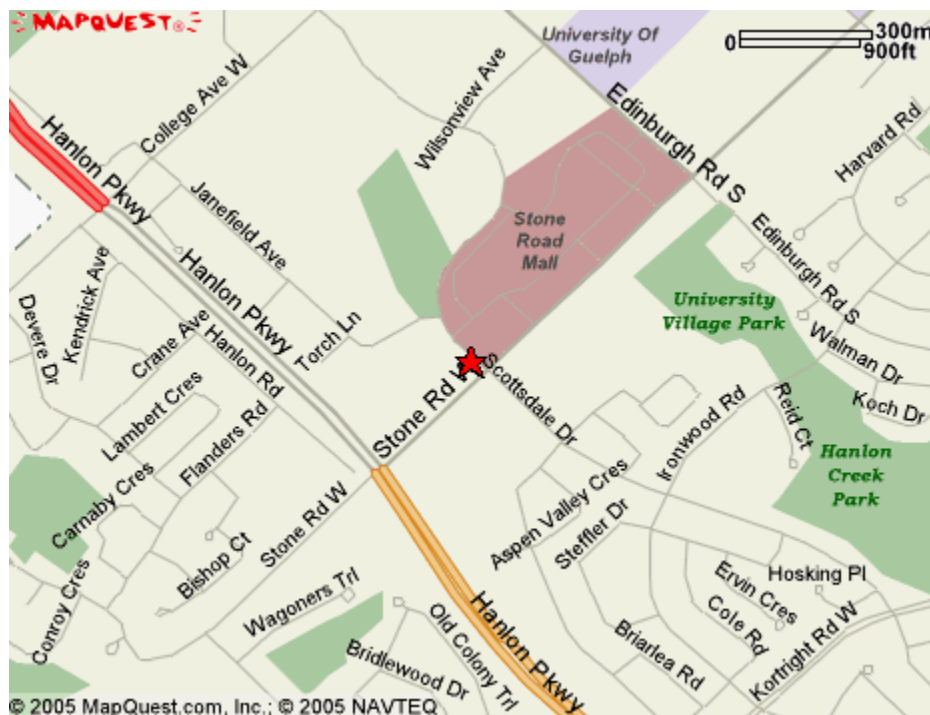

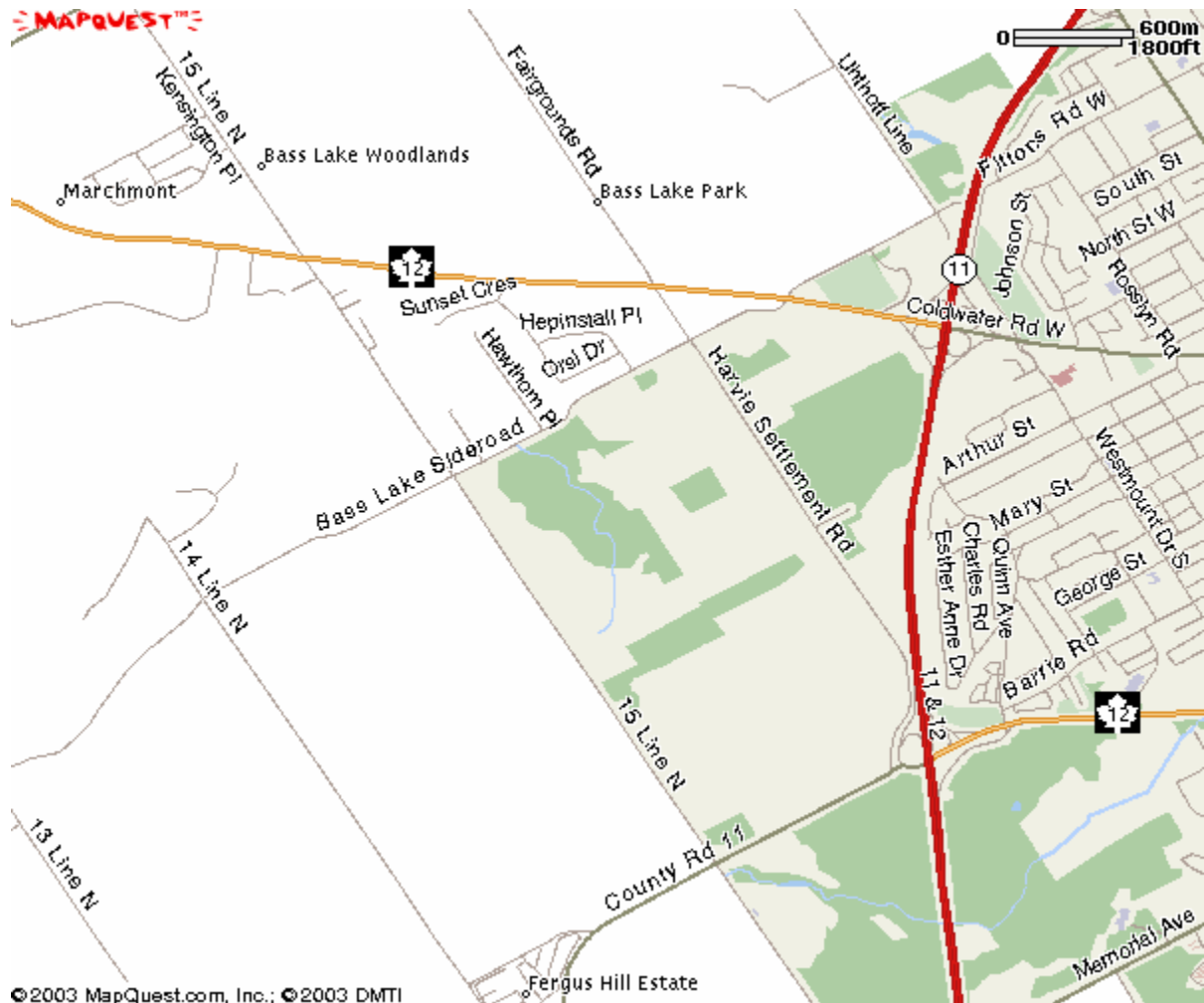

From the North: Hwy 11 South to the Coldwater Road exit. Go North on Coldwater Road to Harvie Settlement Road (Hill Side Church is at the corner). Turn left on Harvie Settlement Road. Notre Dame School on your right hand side.

From the South: Hwy 400 to Hwy 11 North to the Coldwater Road exit. Go North back over Hwy 11 on Coldwater Road to Harvie Settlement Road (Hill Side Church is at the corner). Turn left on Harvie Settlement Road. Notre Dame School on your right hand side.

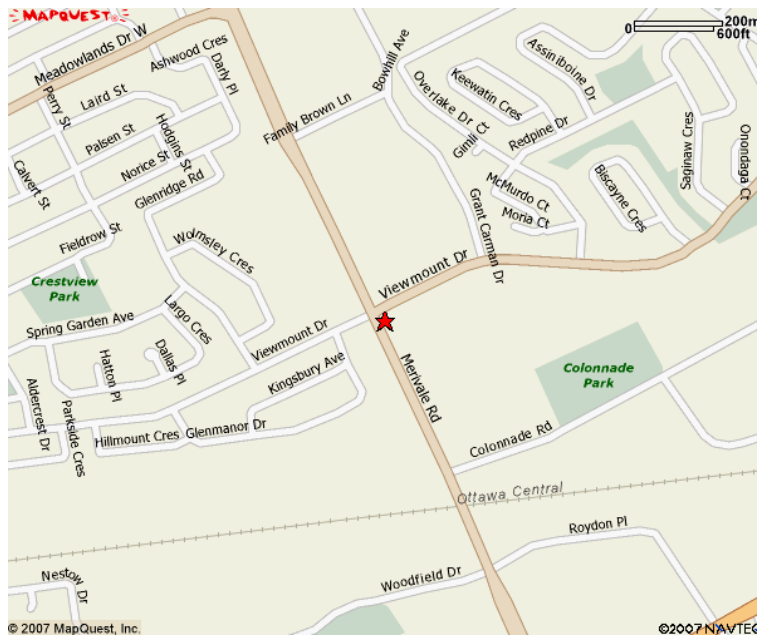

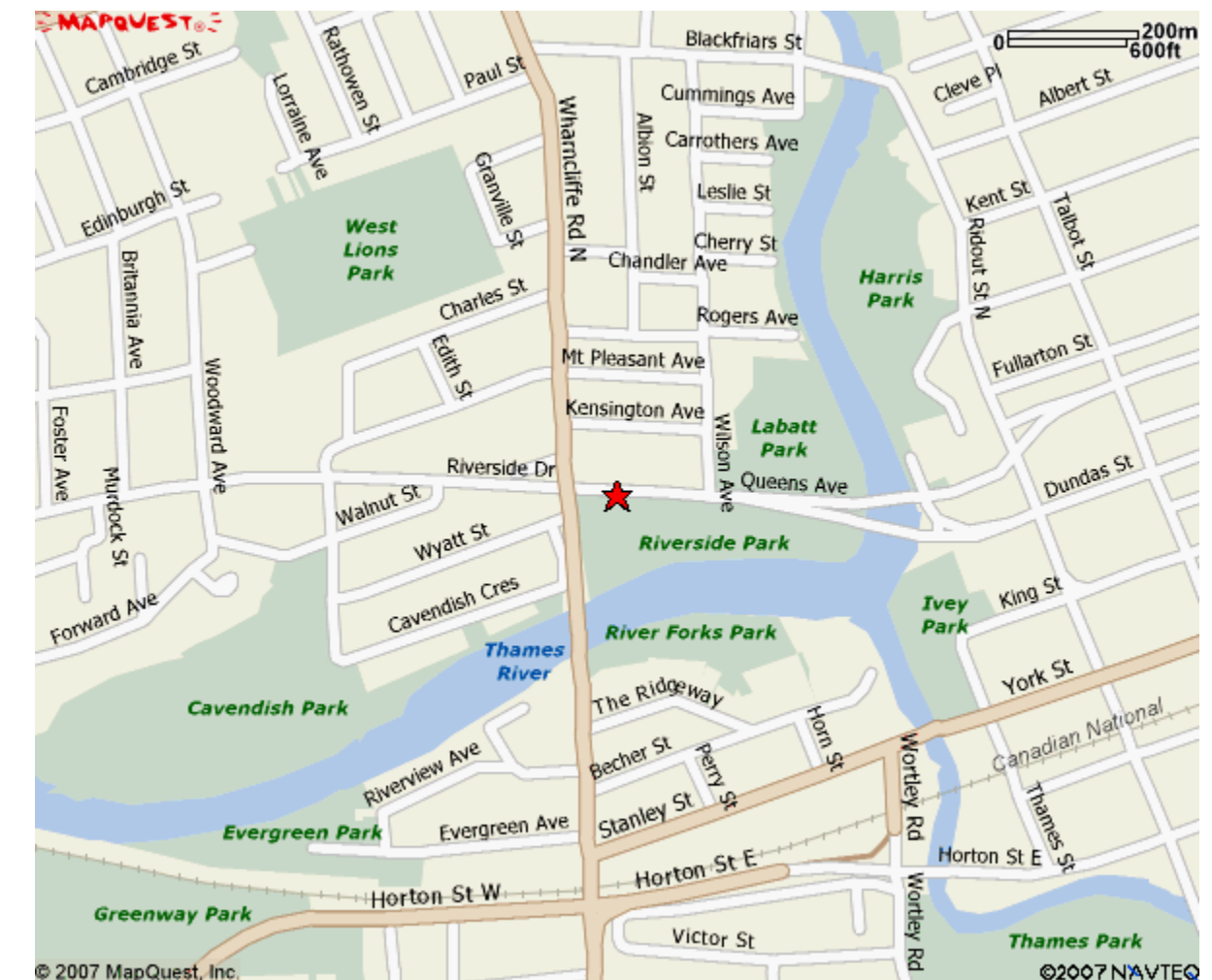

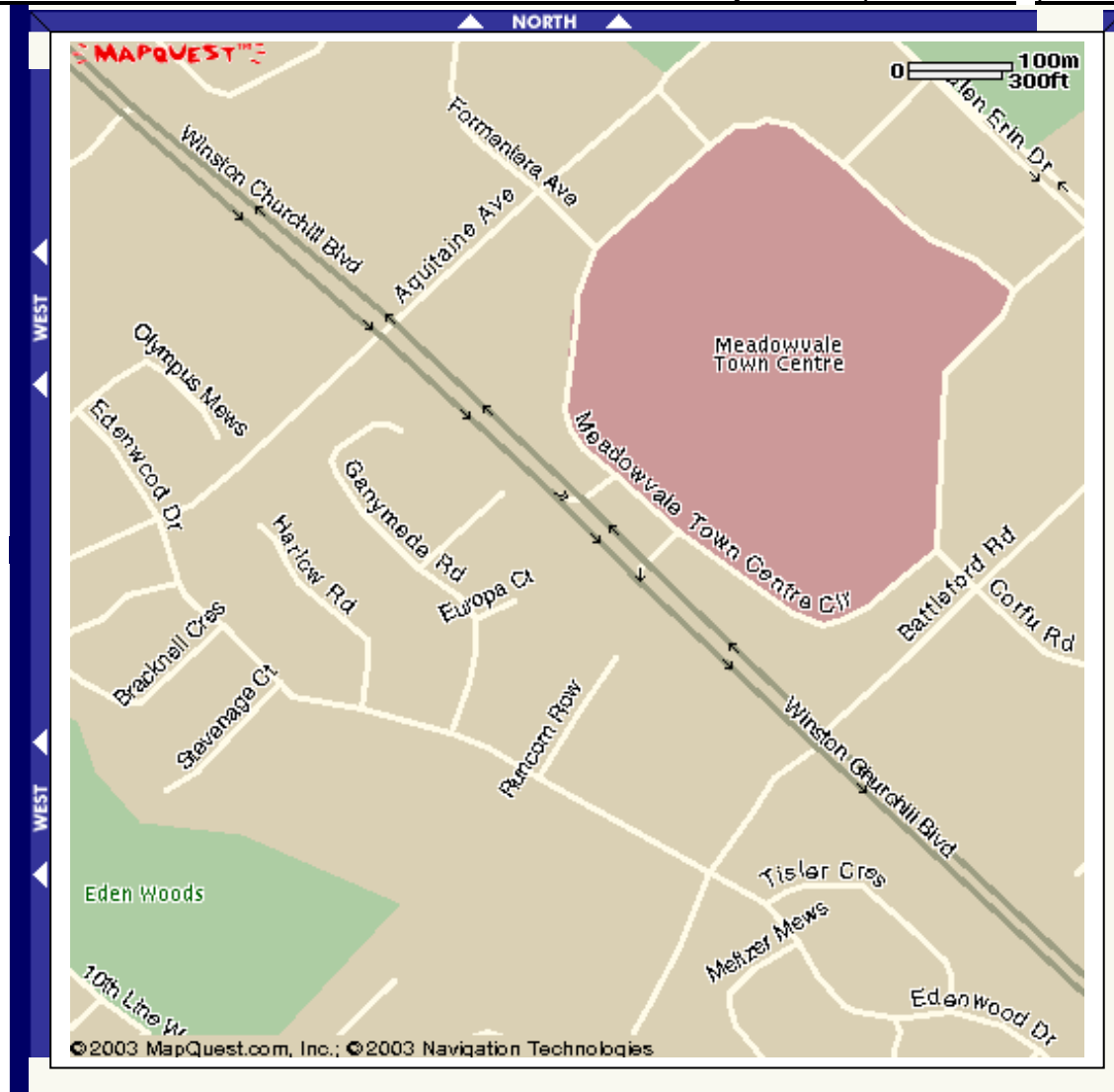
Direction from the West

From the East:

Via the 407: Please note that if you are taking the 407 there is no exit for Winston Churchill Blvd. You must get off at Mississauga Road and go south to Battleford Road. Turn right at Battleford and proceed until you cross Winston Churchill Blvd. (approx. the 4th set of lights). First set of lights after Winston Churchill, you turn right and proceed up Edenwood Drive to the first entrance of the school's parking lot.

Via the 401: Take the 401 West to Winston Churchill Blvd. Go south on Winston Churchill until you reach Battleford Road. There is a church on your right at Battleford. Turn right and then follow the next set of lights (Edenwood Dr) where you will turn right. Follow Edenwood until you reach the first entrance to the school's parking lot.

Via the 403/QEW: Get off the Winston Churchill Blvd. exit and head north. When you reach Battleford Road. Turn left. At the next lights (Edenwood Drive) turn right and then follow Edenwood until you reach the first entrance to the school's parking lot.

From the West

Take the 401 east to Winston Churchill Blvd. Go south on Winston Churchill to Battleford Rd. Get off at the Winston Churchill exit and head north. When you reach Battleford Road turn left. At the next set lights (Edenwood Drive) turn right and then follow Edenwood until you reach the first entrance to the school's parking lot.

Via the 403/QEW: Get off the Winston Churchill Blvd. exit and head north. When you reach Battleford Road. Turn left. At the next lights (Edenwood Drive) turn right and then follow Edenwood until you reach the first entrance to the school's parking lot.

From the East

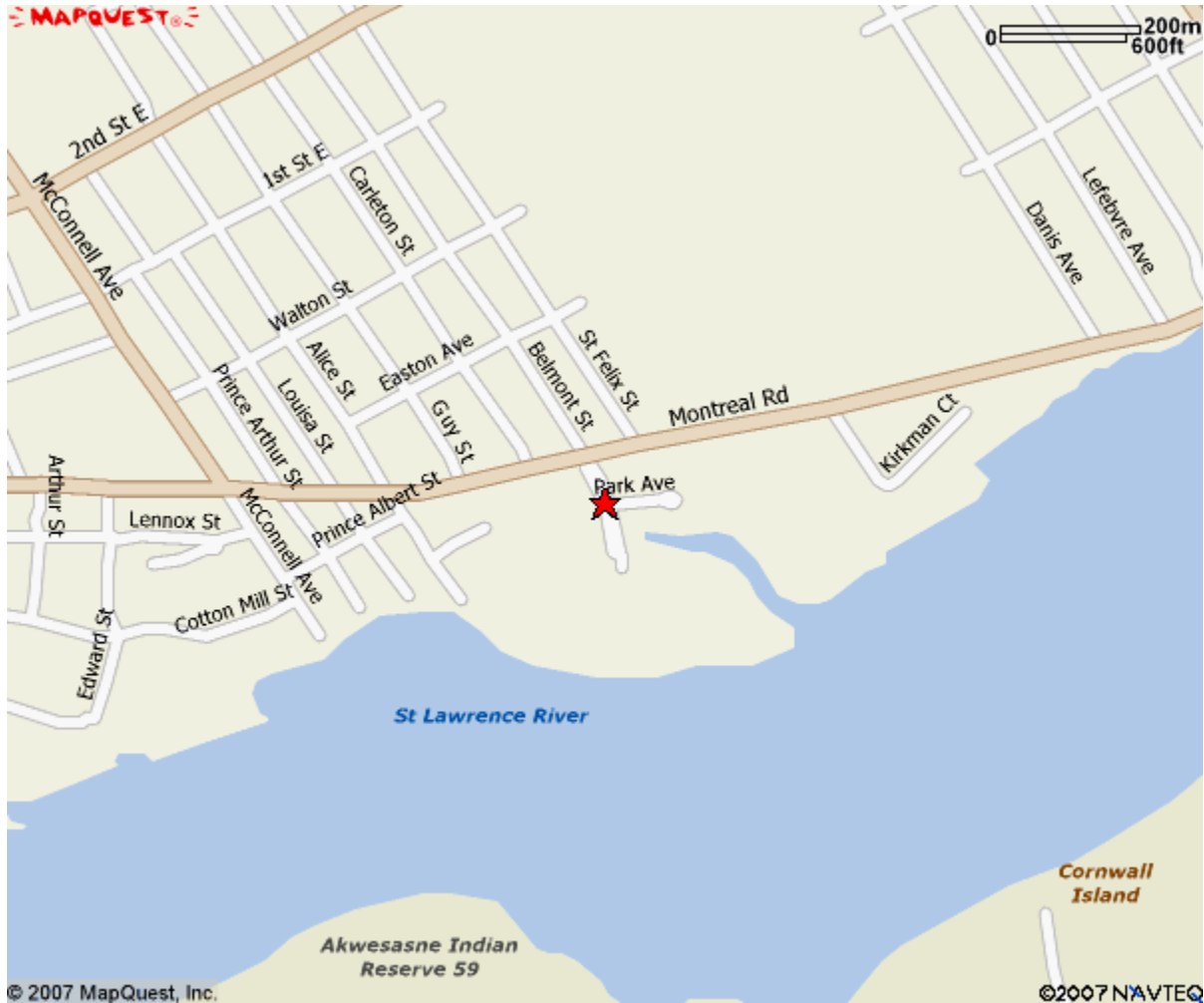
Take the Trans Canada Hwy west to Sudbury. Stay straight and go onto Kingsway Road(RR#55). Stay straight and go onto Elm Street(RR #35). Left turn onto Big Nickel Mine Drive and merge on Highway 17(RR #55) toward Sault Ste. Marie. Turn right onto Balsam Street (RR #32) and follow it to Garrow Road and turn right.

From the South

Take Highway 400 North to Barrie. Highway 400 become Trans Canada highway 69 (same road) and go toward Sudbury. At Sudbury Highway 69 become RR46. Turn LEFT onto RR-37 / BOUCHARD ST. Continue to follow RR-37. Turn RIGHT onto RR-37 / KELLY LAKE RD. Turn LEFT onto RR-55 / LORNE ST. Continue to follow RR-55 W. Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto RR-32 / BALSAM ST. Turn RIGHT onto GARROW RD.
